Teachers are offered guidelines for program selections and are responsible for preparing students adequately. Students receive valuable performance experience in a non-competitive environment along with helpful feedback from judges hired within the local professional community.

Parents can assess the Gold Cup Festival evaluation and help their children reach their goals in subsequent years, as well as receiving assurance that teachers are working for the best outcome and musical education for their child.

Through the Gold Cup Festival, approximately 400 students are heard and evaluated each year. The Festival is growing, and we're proud of our local event! Our **festival entry fee is distributed** across a wide range of expenses including certificates, printing, awards, and honorariums for professional judging. We are very happy to utilize as many local businesses as possible in this endeavor.

Finally, funds left over from entry fees are donated directly to student scholarships across the region for the Rochester Piano Teachers' Guild and New York State Music Teachers Association.
